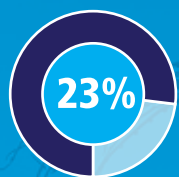

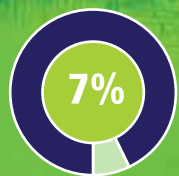

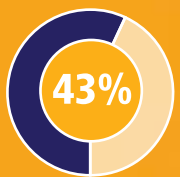

Message from the CEO



In 2021, Nsight focused on supporting our communities as we all continued to navigate through the pandemic. Instead of limiting themselves to what is, the Nsight family continually asked, what is possible? How can we help uplift others and make an impact on the world around us?

Possibilities flourished as we came together with community partners to make a difference. While remaining virtual, the Cellcom Green Bay Marathon awarded \$75,510 to local nonprofits and COVID-19 relief efforts! The pandemic produced an increased need for the services provided by this year's charity partners, as the funds raised focused on tackling hunger, homelessness and mental health concerns.

Environmental stewardship will always be of great importance to Nsight. Nonprofits such as the Fox-Wolf Watershed Alliance, advocating for the protection of water resources in the Fox-Wolf River Basin, and the Northwoods Wildlife Center, working

to protect wildlife through rehabilitation and education, are just two of 25 organizations that were selected to receive Green Gifts in 2021. These gifts are made possible by Cellcom's phone recycling program and customers committed to the environment and sustainability.

Nsight eagerly supported youth and education, as children spent the year exploring the possibilities of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) through opportunities like Einstein's Sandbox and the STEM Shuttle. Scholarships helped shape the future of 25 students of the Class of 2021.

As the landscape of how we give back may look different during these times, our commitment to positively impact our communities remains steadfast. Thank you for allowing us to discover the power of what is possible when we come together.

Einstein's Sandbox

In the summer of 2021, the Einstein Project launched Einstein's Sandbox, a mobile makerspace designed to engage kids of all ages in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math). The creativity lab traveled to parks in Green Bay, Appleton and Oshkosh, bringing opportunities to tinker, create and learn. Each month, kids experienced new themed projects and challenges as they expanded the bounds of creativity and learning. Cellcom provided a mobile hotspot to help run the exciting STEM tools such as a 3D printer and laser cutter. Approximately 494 children, ages 5-13, participated in these hands-on activities and let their imaginations soar.

STEM Shuttle

The STEM Shuttle combines outer space and STEM for elementary and middle school students as it travels throughout Wisconsin. Kids take part in workstations aboard the shuttle, expanding their knowledge and understanding of space travel. Immersive activities such as using a robotic arm to simulate working in outer space allow participants to experience real-world applications of what they learn in the classroom. Cellcom provided the shuttle with smartphones to help make each mission a reality.



Scholarships

Each year, Nsight supports high school seniors as they pursue higher education. In 2021, 25 students were recognized and awarded a combined total of \$21,900.

Seven students received the \$1,200 Nsight Telservices scholarship and 16 students were awarded the \$750 Cellcom scholarship. Each scholarship recipient demonstrated academic success and leadership in their schools and community.

Two Pulaski High School students received the Ray J. Riordan, Jr. Scholarship, a \$750 award given to editors of the Pulaski News.

Cellcom Green Bay Marathon

With community safety top of mind, the Cellcom Green Bay Marathon continued to stay virtual in 2021. That didn't stop participants from pushing the boundaries of what is possible and coming together to raise money for local nonprofits. The funds raised this year went towards COVID-19 relief initiatives and focused on areas of hunger, homelessness and mental health.

A total of \$75,510 was raised for the 2021 charity partners:

Oneida Nation Emergency Food Pantry

- Funds stocked the pantry and covered transportation costs to deliver food to high-risk and quarantined families and individuals.

St. John the Evangelist Homeless Shelter

- Funds provided emergency shelter services, sanitation supplies, basic needs, transportation and motel vouchers for those in need.

Casa ALBA Melanie

- Funds increased support for those who were unable to access federal and state assistance, including childcare, medical prescriptions or supplies, temporary housing or shelter and transportation.

New Community Shelter

- Funds helped support the shelter's community meal and emergency shelter programs.

Paul's Pantry

- Funds were used to purchase food items for individuals and families in the community facing increased need.

Russel Leicht Disabled American Veterans Chapter 3

- Funds went directly to helping veterans who are financially unstable and potentially experiencing homelessness.

The Gathering Place

- Funds helped those experiencing mental health challenges compounded by financial hardships due to the pandemic.

Green Gifts

Through Cellcom's Green Gifts program, \$30,266 was given to 25 non-profit organizations, programs and projects. This year's Green Gifts focused on expanding access and opportunities for nature encounters, educational efforts, natural resource conservation and inspiring the next generation of environmental advocates.

Green Gifts is funded through money generated from Cellcom's cell phone recycling program, made possible by individual efforts.

Givin' A Little Back

Each year, as an Nsight family, we strive to put our words into actions and commitments into outcomes.

The Givin' A Little Back (GALB) program allows employees to turn their philanthropic efforts into monetary donations to a non-profit organization of their choice. In 2021, employees spent 2,862 hours volunteering and gave \$4,681 in personal donations. Nsight extended these contributions, giving a total of \$9,381 to 77 unique organizations.

United Way

During Nsight's Annual United Way Campaign, employees donated \$4,812 and Nsight matched this amount for a total of \$9,624. This money helped support seven local United Way agencies in the Nsight service area, providing needed support for local communities and residents.

Vertical Bridge Partnership

Cellcom teamed up with its tower partner, Vertical Bridge, to help local food pantries. Together, the companies donated \$7,500, subsidizing meal programs and stocking shelves in local communities.
